- 5. The framework will help the need for gold, and the post most appropriate to act as gold, to be identified quickly. But there is an additional need to decide on who the appropriate person to be contacted in an out-of-hours emergency should be. Black Rod is the appropriate person in the Lords; the BCPSG has not expressed a view on the appropriate person in the Commons.
