NOTE This Order is subject to special parliamentary procedure by reason of section 128 of the Planning Act 2008 in that the Order authorises the compulsory acquisition of land and rights over land belonging to bodies who are statutory undertakers for the purposes of s. 128 who made, and did not withdraw, representations about the application for development consent, and the application was not made by a statutory undertaker.

Section 24 of the Growth and Infrastructure Act 2013 repealed s.128 of the 2008 Act relating to special parliamentary procedure. However, by virtue of article 7(1) of the Growth and Infrastructure Act 2013 (Commencement No. 1 and Transitional and Saving Provisions) Order 2013 (S.I. 2013/1124), that repeal does not apply in relation to this Order.
